

Need for

- involvement with those with governance responsibilities
- co-design

Very initial discussions with

- Tasman District Council identified a possible issue
 - Managing the health of the subtidal benthic environment
- local iwi identified two related issues
 - Fisheries degradation
 - Catchment-sea management

What next?

- Need to determine a process initially with
 - Tasman District Council
 - He Pou Tokomanawa (Kaitiakitanga in Practice) to determine shared aspirations for the area
 - Iwi – Te Atiawa, Ngati Rarua, Ngati Tama, Ngati Koata (Tiakina te Taiao)

What do we all want !
- Expand discussions to include Nelson City Council, central government agencies (including MPI), industries and local communities
 - Refine issue(s) and set communication/involvement protocols

What next?

- Create work plan identifying
 - whether work that is required is already planned
 - where information generated here can be used in other projects
 - gaps in knowledge, processes and tools
 - determine best way to fill gaps
 - Re-strategising other projects milestones
 - New small projects
 - External funding sources

- Conducted some of the underpinning science

- Identified and tested participatory processes
- Identified barriers to EBM implementation
- Investigated with partners ways to embed EBM in planning and policy processes
- Demonstrated a variety of management tools from the EBM Managed Seas toolbox
- Built capacity in public use of these tools
- Contributed to the development of Challenge Phase II Plan.
